Rights Respecting Ambassador (RRS)

Job Description

As an RRS Ambassador, you will be expected to:

- Be **reliable, responsible, respectful** role models for the younger children
- Promoting the rights of the child and the RRS values across the school
- Attend monthly RRS meetings
- Deliver KS1 and KS2 assemblies
- Contribute to a termly newsletter, communicating plans with the school community
- Plan and implement RRS themed fundraising events within and beyond the school community
- Run a Healthy Tuck Shop
- Support lunchtimes, rewarding and promoting Healthy Choices

As a member of the RRS team, you will help with generating ways in which to support the whole school theme of Healthy Choices. You will attend monthly meetings (run by Mrs Stockall and Mrs O'Reilly) to suggest ideas and generate plans. Ideas and plans will be communicated to pupils through termly assemblies, and to the wider community through a termly newsletter. RRS Ambassadors will help to support the school in promoting Healthy Choices, by running a weekly Healthy Tuck Shop, support in the lunch hall with rewarding healthy lunches and implementing new initiative that encourage increased physical activity.
