Job Description

As a School Councillor, you will be expected to:

- Be **reliable, responsible, respectful** role models for the younger children
- Attend monthly School Council meetings and report back the thoughts from your class
- Hold a class discussion in a monthly class assembly, gathering ideas from peers
- Deliver KS1 and KS2 assemblies
- Create a termly newsletter, communicating plans and ideas with the school community
- Support whole school initiatives and other Young Leaders (RRS and Eco)
- Form an interview panel during the staff recruitment procedure

As a member of the School Council, you will contribute to whole school discussions and support in the implementation of School Improvement initiatives. The School Council members will hold a class assembly termly to gather feedback from their peers on whole school matters. These will then be shared in a monthly School Council meeting (run by Mrs Morris). In these meetings, you will share feedback, give opinions and generate ideas for school improvement and ways in which to support the whole school theme of Healthy Choices and Sustainability. Ideas and plans will be communicated to pupils through termly assemblies, and to the wider community through a termly newsletter. During staff recruitment, selected members of the School Council may be asked to form an interview panel that will form part of the recruitment procedure.
