Job Description

As an Eco Representative, you will be expected to:

- Be **reliable, responsible, respectful** role models for the younger children
- Look after the school environment
- Support, plan and implement Eco initiatives
- Attend monthly Eco meetings
- Contribute to a termly newsletter, communicating plans with the school community
- Plan and implement fundraising events (alongside the RRS team) within and beyond the school community
- Monitor shared areas and classrooms for unnecessary use of electricity

As a member of the Eco team, you will help with generating ways in which to support the whole school Sustainability. You will attend monthly meetings (run by Miss Lockyear) to suggest ideas and generate plans for supporting the local and wider community with Environment issues. Ideas and plans may be communicated to pupils through termly assemblies, and to the wider community through a termly newsletter. Eco representatives will monitor the school for tidiness and environmental issues, e.g saving electricity, recycling and litter picking. They will promote Eco friendly initiatives throughout the school with marketing and promote this at all times.
