Job Description

You will be responsible for joining the Key Stage One pupils during their morning and lunch time play outside. You will be expected to:

- Be **reliable, responsible, respectful** role models for the younger children
- Play active, inclusive games with small groups of pupils
- Develop your own leadership skills
- Encourage and model positive behaviour
- Promote healthy, active choices
- Use Rights Respecting Schools language with pupils
- Ensure that the playground charter is followed and seek help from adults when necessary
- Support the PE Leader (Miss Southon) with the designing, planning and organisation of Sports Days

Successful applicants are each given one day in the week to carry out their duties (around 4 play leaders per day). On your day you will be required on the Orchard Playground at 10.15am – 10.35am to support Year One and 12.30 pm – 1.00pm to support Year Two. Each session that you deliver will earn you one stamp on your Play Leader Ladder (2 stamps per week) and certificates can be earned on your Play Leader journey. Once you have reached the top of the ladder, you will become a Trainer for the next cohort of Play Leaders!

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for **reliable, responsible, respectful** pupils who will be **role models** for the younger children. Someone who is kind, caring and positive would be perfect for this role. If you get pleasure from playing with younger pupils and helping them to make the right choices, this is the job for you!
